• Report of 2012 Show Committee – Trish Mims

- First the final budget for the 2012 Conformation shows is attached. We received a check from the Combined last night for \$385.10. The final losses on the two 2012 Conformation shows are as follows:
- March lost (\$293.95), and July lost (\$694.80) for a total loss on conformation shows for 2012 of (\$988.75).

- Application approved for March 2013, all pending items cleared with AKC.
- Aubrey has been very ill. Nancy Colson will monitor and take necessary steps should he be unable to fulfill the assignment.
- We have no possibilities for sweepstakes judges at this time. Given the typical entry at the March show discuss was held about cancelling sweepstakes for this event. Motions was made by Joyce Young, seconded by



- Karen Murray that we cancel sweepstakes associated with the March 2013 show. Motion passed. Nancy Colson will notify the AKC of this cancellation.

New Business

<u>Houston Combined Specialty Meeting Report – September 26, 2012</u>

Tom P said this was the smoothest run show the HCS has had in years. No problems or catastrophes reported. They attribute part of that to the closing of the doors early to allow for the working dog shows. It forced people to get in early and get things situated early.

Details for March 2013 -

Houston KC will be charging \$28 per entry for the first entry. Closing date is February 27, 2013.

The premium list has been received and forwarded to Nancy Colson for first proof. It's due back to the Combined by October 19, 2012.

The show applications to the AKC must be done by October 24, 2012.

Ad pages for the catalog cost the club \$25. We can charge whatever we want above that price.

Sweepstakes break even entry fee is \$20. We have already set our fees for 2013 to allow for this.

July 2012 Review

Judging Schedule: There was a complaint from the GSP who were in the ring after us about our finishing late. I mentioned to Larry Chu that this is perpetually a problem for any breed with multiple varieties. He said that "Onofrio" only allows 2.5 minutes per dog and does NOT allow adequate for time for intervariety judging. I apologized to the GSP folks and told Larry we had rushed people through the ring at a ridiculous rate, moved our trophies etc and done everything we could to allow for the GSP to start on time. The judging schedule simply DOES NOT allow enough time for any breed with inter-variety judging to finish. He said he requests a 30 minute "cushion" between each breed in a given ring. He said if he will allow a 1 hour cushion after our breed for the 2013 shows if we remind him when judging times are requested for 2013.

Onofrio Costs for July 2013: We can expect an increase in Onofrio's costs for July 2013 of approximately 3% - making their charge per entry \$10.60 for a regular entry and \$6.45 for a second entry.

Entry Fees: Houston Kennel Club will charge \$32 for the first entry and \$23 for the second entry for July 2013. Many of the clubs reported that they are increasing their entry fee to match the fees charged the rest of the weekend.

Other notes – the overall entry at the all breeds was down about 400 dogs. Overall gate was down as far as people coming in but they made more \$\$ because there were less kids and more adults paying full price admission.

The possibility of adding a second "parent club" sponsored event in the evening on Thursday was discussed by several breeds. They are hoping it will be a way to bring in more entries and more \$\$.

The HCS membership approved the Norwegian Elkhounds request to drop out of the July shows and hold back to back shows in March. They get no entry in July and their dogs are in better coat in March. I voiced a concern about this as we have noted on several occasions the similar problem with our entry in March and been told we cannot drop out of the March shows. I felt it would start a precedence that could be a problem to allow this and not allow clubs to drop out of March if they had a good reason. Larry Chu stated that the Houston KC recognizes the desirability of offering 3 shows for the weekend in March and pays the entire rental fee on the facility for the Combined. They still will not allow clubs to leave the March specialty and do two shows in July unless their parent club will not permit them to host more than one specialty a year. This motion passed with a majority of the HCS members present voting in favor.

Dog cc and Runner Up Best Of Breed being "UNO" Aust/Mal Ch Hacienda Blessed Assurance, bred by Gopi Krishnan who is sired by a Rabows homered Stud "Little Jack" or "L.J." a son of Rabows Tru Power of Won "Jackpot". Interestingly enough the Breed Winner and Runner-Up are of Dacshoe decent by way of American soil! The Australian National drew an entry of over 330 dachshunds over all coats and sizes, with the second highest entry being in the miniature longhair.

Judge Pamela Peat continued on to shock us all by then awarding Aust Ch Rabows Charmed One Best In Show, officially bringing the total number of Miniature Longhair



Dachshunds to EVER win at the Australian Nationals to a grand total of TWO (2), the first of which was Aust Ch American Ch Wagsmore Salutation ML, from yet another American Miniature Longhair kennel!

Ch Rabows Royal Envoy of Mardigras ML finished her Championship and was professionally presented by Tara Hartman (Tarlyn) of PA. "Muffin" was bred by Rhonda Doty (Mardigras) and owned by Melissa Sworab. Muffin is the first Cream ML Champion for Rabows.

Tara also exquisitely presented our lovely Hope to her Grand Champion title making her GCh Hacienda Divine Virtue. Tara continued to show Hope (affectionately known as "Mama Hope" due to her multiple winning kids including Ch Big Hope and Pointed Little Hope) to MULTIPLE Group placements, including a Group Second and a Group Fourth! Hope is the first Standard Smooth Champion and first Standard Smooth Grand Champion as well as the first Group placing dog of any size and coat for Rabows! Mama Hope was bred by Gopi Krishnan and owned by Melissa Sworab.
